VEHICLE RESTRAINTS -MESSAGE FROM POLICE

Safety belts support you in a crash or when the vehicle stops suddenly. Without a belt, front seat occupants can be thrown through the windscreen and onto the road. Back seat passengers can be thrown onto the front seats, the front seat passengers, or can hit the roof. Wearing a safety belt reduces the risk of being killed or seriously injured in a road crash by about 40%. If everyone wore their safety belts an estimated 25 lives could be saved from road crashes each year. All modern cars must be fitted with safety belts in the front and back seats. Safety belts must be worn in front and back seats if fitted. If you're 15 years or over and drive or ride in a vehicle without wearing safety belt you can be fined. If you're the driver you can be fined if you have a passenger aged under 15 riding in your vehicle without wearing a safety belt or child restraint.
