Alert Level One Fairburn School

At Fairburn School there are no major changes at Alert level one, we will continue to have a strong focus on hygiene practices that include regular hand washing and encouraging safe sneezing and coughing techniques. All drinking fountains will remain closed during this time so all children need to continue to bring a drink to school.

Any children who are sick must remain at home, if they show signs of sickness they will be asked to be collected from school.

We can now look forward to school assemblies, inter-school and community sport, cultural events and performances and to welcoming all of our school community on site for these activities.

We will continue to lock gates from 9.00 am till 2.40 pm. The only access to the school, during this time, will be through the Pukeora Rd gate. If you need to collect your child early you need to report to the office to sign them out.

To avoid congestion at school we strongly encourage families to say farewell to their children at home / car / school gate or a designated pick up point and not enter the school site and encourage the same arrangement in the afternoon.

At the end of the school day if a child is unable to meet at the pickup point / car, then a parent can go to the classroom and **wait till 2.50 pm** to collect their child. **Please note there are no more early pickups from classrooms unless you have a white slip from the office.**
