The New Curriculum

As you are aware, the new New Zealand Curriculum is being implemented throughout the country at present. Safety Reminder

Ear Clinic Visit

The Ear Clinic Van will be visiting the school from 2 June until 18 June. The Ear Nurse examines those children who have failed their recent hearing and/or screening test, or who have ongoing ear problems. Parents are welcome to attend with their children and to bring any preschool children if they are worried about their hearing.

Free Raincoats

A number of years ago we registered as a partner school in the KidsCan initiatives. KidsCan provide items such as clothing and food to schools at no cost. We have just been informed that KidsCan are able to supply every child at Fairburn School with an Adidas All Black Raincoat which is not only warm and dry, but also has the silver fern on the chest. The raincoats will be distributed early June to coincide with the All Blacks test matches. If you do <u>not</u> want your child to receive a raincoat please let your child's teacher know.
