## **Road Safety Week**

This is road safety week and the focus is on not getting distracted while you are driving. The Police have informed us they will be doing random checks at the school gate for adults wearing their seat belts and children being in proper car seats and seatbelts. The law changed last year and now all children up to 7 years old must be in proper "booster seats" with seat belts to keep them safe. The Police will be *giving drivers tickets if they have children in the vehicle who are not properly restrained*. This will cost \$150 per ticket!

You can buy your own car seat or hire one through Plunket. The Otahuhu Plunket Clinic is at 3 Alexander St Otahuhu (Ph 09 276 6354), it is open on Fridays. There is also a Plunket Clinic in Papatoetoe at 25 Kolmar Rd Papatoetoe (09 278 3834) it is open from 9.30am til 1pm on Thursdays.

On Friday, we are asking all of our students and staff to wear bright colours as part of our Road Safety "Bright Day" to highlight the need to "be safe and be seen."
