## **SKIDS After School Care Progamme**

Thank you to all of the families who returned your slips to let us know whether you would use an after-school care programme if it was available. We are pleased to say that more than 70 families indicated they were likely to use this service. The board has agreed that SKIDS can set up a programme in our school. We will keep you informed about our progress with this but we are looking forward to having SKIDS as part of our school community – hopefully this will start before the end of the year.

## Reminders

There are a number of reminders that we want to give you so that things run smoothly for your children as we "race" towards the end of the year.

- Please name all of your child's property clothing, school bag, hat etc so that if they are lost we have a better chance of tracking them down.
- Every child needs a sunhat at school every day in Term 4 and in Term 1, we have a selection of caps that can be bought through the office, but they can wear any hat they own.
- Please take care when driving or parking around our school, it's a very busy
  place and we need all the adults to help keep our students safe as they move
  in and out of the school.

## **Decile of Our School**

You may have heard that the Decile ranking of schools has been updated following the Census data from last year being made available. All schools have a Decile rating and it is determined on a range of information that the Census collected from every household in NZ. A school's decile rating is based on the socio-economic status of the communities where the school's students live. Our school funding is determined by our decile ranking. The Ministry uses five indicators of socio-economic status for a community:

- Percentage of households with income in the lowest 20 percent nationally
- Percentage of employed parents in lowest occupational groups
- Household crowding
- Percentage of parents with no educational qualifications
- Percentage of parents receiving income support benefits

Fairburn School is currently a Decile 2d. Our school is in one of the lowest socio-economic communities in the country. The new decile for our school from the beginning of next year is Decile 1c, it is one band lower than we are at the moment. The good news is that with the move to Decile 1c, our school will receive another \$69,500 per year – *this is fabulous news*. It will mean we can spend more money on exciting learning programmes and resources for our students.

There is no relationship between the quality of the teaching and learning in a school and its socio-economic or decile rank.
