#### OTAHUHU READERS GET AN EXTRA DAY IN THE LIBRARY

Auckland Council has voted to standardise library opening hours across the city. From July opening hours in Auckland's 59 libraries will be 44, 48, 52 or 56 a week, except for Central City Library which is open for 67 hours a week. Otahuhu Library will see the biggest change in South Auckland, going from 48.5 hours, six days a week to 56 hours and seven days a week.
