STATIONERY

Thank you to all the families who have already organised the stationery for their children, this makes a real difference to them. HATS

A reminder that sunhats are a 'must have and must wear' during Term 1 for every student. At the moment, there are still a number of students who are not able to move out of the shaded areas as they do not yet have a hat. We are happy to see students wearing their own hat as long as it does cover their heads and provide protection from the sun on their face and neck. We do have hats for sale at school - bucket hats \$7 and caps \$6 both in a range of colours. Please clearly name your child's hat.

AFTER SCHOOL

At 3pm, any students still at school waiting for parents will be moved to the 'waiting area' which is the covered seating outside our library. They will be supervised there and you will need to come in and collect them by 3.10pm. This is for their safety. If you are going to be late picking up your child, please ring the school office so we know what is happening for them. If you know you are going to be late, you can enrol them in the SKiDS after-school care programme so you know where they are.

SCHOOL ENROLMENT SCHEME

Our enrolment zone was approved by the Ministry of Education and came in to effect from the beginning of this year. We will have some space for "out of zone" applications and will have a ballot for these at the end of March. This will enable a Term 2 start. Students need to be on our wait-list for this to happen. *Please let us know NOW if you* have a child starting school this year.

SWIMMING

Swimming is part of the NZ curriculum and a very important part of your child's programme at school. For the first month of our swimming season, our Year 3 to Year 6 students have swimming lessons with trained instructors as part of an agreement with the Auckland Council. This is a fabulous opportunity for our students so please make sure that your child has their togs every swimming day.

LUNCH ROOM

Our lunch room sells a range of delicious food for lunch. The menu has changed a little so please check the menu before you decide on what your children will have. We do have a school food policy that guides what students should bring to school for lunch and snacks, as a general rule, fizzy drinks, lollies and 'packaged' foods like chippies and other similar snacks should be left at home.
