BIKES AT SCHOOL

Just a reminder, only Year 5 and <u>6 students</u> are permitted to ride their bicycles to and from school. The bicycles must be stored in the bicycle rack behind the swimming pool. They must <u>NOT</u> be ridden in the school grounds. All bicycles are brought to school at the owner's risk. Students who ride bicycles to school must wear a New Zealand standard compliant cycle helmet at all times (maintained to the required standards). The helmet must be adjusted correctly and securely fastened. Parents, caregivers and students are responsible for maintaining the bike in accordance with the current NZ bike code. We do not allow students to ride scooters to school—only bicycles. Thank you for your support in this matter.
