CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Cases of COVID-19 have now been confirmed in New Zealand. The Ministry of Health's expert advisory group provides a list of countries or territories of concern on their website. The Ministry of Education is working closely with the Ministry of Health to provide the most up to date information to schools, families and caregivers. Please continue to send students to school as normal. Fairburn School has procedures in place should there be any concern for the safety and wellbeing of our students. Everybody should follow these basic principles to reduce the risk of any type of infection (not just coronavirus) or illness or passing it on to others

- regularly washing hands (for at least 20 seconds with water and soap and dry thoroughly)
- covering your mouth and nose when you sneeze
- staying home if you are sick and seek medical attention
- avoiding close contact with anyone with cold or flu-like symptoms
- if you feel unwell you should avoid public gatherings and events
- cleaning surfaces regularly (when infection is suspected).
