#### New Work at School

During the holidays, we have had a lot of new work done around the school with more to be completed. The old dental clinic by Rm 5 has been converted in to smaller teaching and learning spaces for



literacy or numeracy programmes. Rms 5&6 have been refurbished and look very nice inside now. New disabled accessways have been developed for all classrooms in the middle school – Rms 15-22 and the work is ongoing to complete the ramps needed around Rms 23-26 to enable wheel chair access to these areas.



#### Stationery

Your child will bring home a stationery list for the year. We encourage you to purchase the pack for each Year level, however, if

you want to purchase this elsewhere, please ask teachers for a full list so you can do this. If you are unable to pay for all of the stationery for your children now, please talk to one of the Deputy Principals or myself and we can work with you to make sure every child gets what they need as soon as possible.

#### Hats

A reminder that all students *MUST* wear a hat when they are outside during

Term 1 and Term 4. If they do not have a hat, they need to stay under the covered areas. This means they can't always play with their friends. If your child doesn't have a suitable hat, we have caps for sale for \$6 in a range of colours, these are available through the office.

can update our database. It is very important that we have this information as we may need to get in touch for a variety of reasons, most importantly in an emergency if your child is sick or injured and we need to take action.

**The first bell goes at 8.15am** – this is the time that children should start arriving at school. Children arriving earlier than this sit on the seats outside Rms 15-22 until the bell goes at 8.15am.

Lunchtime is from 12.30 – 1.20pm (Lunch is eaten between 1.05pm and 1.20pm) School finishes at 2.50pm

All students should be picked up as soon as possible after 2.50pm. If you are going to be later than 3.05pm, please let the school office know. All children should be out of the school by 3.15pm at the latest. No supervision is available before 8.15am and after 3.15pm.
